**D**r. Lu-Jean Feng is an internationally renowned Microvascular Plastic and Reconstructive Surgeon. She is the Founder and Medical Director of <sup>The</sup> Lu-Jean Feng Clinic, an attending surgeon at University Hospitals of Cleveland, and an Associate Clinical Professor of Surgery at Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine.

Dr. Feng graduated from Yale College and Yale Medical School and has been performing plastic surgery for more than 20 years. She is unique within her field, as female plastic surgeons comprise a mere 4% of the total industry. Dr. Feng is a 2006 recipient of the prestigious Ellis Island Medal of Honor for her accomplishments as a U.S. citizen, she was selected as one of the Top Ten Women Business Owners in 2006 by the North American Women Business Owners Association, and she is a 2007 recipient of the highly acclaimed Rainmaker award for her contributions in the healthcare industry.

Widely recognized for her expertise in the field of microvascular breast reconstruction involving autogenous tissue transplantation, she is also highly acclaimed for her research and work toward understanding the effects of breast implants on the human body. Her articles have been published in several prominent medical journals including, *Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery* and *Cancer*. Dr. Feng has currently concluded a ten year study which helped her to develop a "painless/drainless" tummy tuck procedure with minimal recovery time. She also specializes in cosmetic surgery of the face and breasts.

Over the years, Dr. Feng's own personal beliefs and ideals regarding fitness, nutrition, and healthy living have evolved in every aspect of her practice. <sup>The</sup> Lu-Jean Feng Clinic opened in 2000 as a premier state-of-the-art outpatient surgery center.
